### **DIRECTIONS**

**Trains leave from the Old Colony & Newport Railway depot at 19 America's Cup Avenue, just north of the Newport Transportation and Visitors Center and one block north of the Marriot Hotel. Parking is available at the depot.**

*From the west:* After crossing the Newport Bridge, take the first exit into downtown Newport. The Depot is on your right as you enter downtown on America's Cup Ave.

*From the north and east:* Take Route 24 to Aquidneck Island, then follow Route 114 to Route 138 (west). Follow the signs to downtown Newport. See directions above.
